Drivers - Keep our children safe!



It has been brought to our attention that the parking and driving behaviours of some of our families around the big hall car park when dropping off and picking up their child/ren are putting their child/ren and others safety at risk.

After school, we ask that you find a free car park to pull into so your child

can safely walk over to you.

Please do not park in the middle of the carpark or by the big hall and call your child over, this is dangerous and hazardous to your child as often they are not looking

when they cross the carpark. Parking in the middle of the car park also stops the flow of traffic causing irritation to those who have safely parked to pick up their child/ren.

There are clear yellow broken lines around the big hall building as pictured, **please keep this area clear at all times - No**



Parking - like you would with broken yellow lines on the road. This allows for an easy flow of traffic and cars that are parked facing the field can park and reverse safely without children running behind them to the cars that have been parked along the big hall.
